Billy had \$5.00 when he went to the theater. If he bought 1 water what is the most expensive item he can buy with the money he has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$2.20 = \$2.80$$

- 2) The table below shows the prices of several items at the sports store.

Item	Price
helmet	\$1.65
baseball	\$3.40
glove	\$1.45
bat	\$2.10
hat	\$3.85

Kaleb had \$5.00 when he went to the store. If he bought 1 baseball what is the most expensive item he can buy with the money he has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$3.40 = \$1.60$$

- 4) The table below shows the prices of several items at a clothing store.

Item	Price
hat	\$2.60
scarf	\$1.50
t-shirt	\$3.00
jacket	\$3.95
hoodie	\$4.00

Robin had \$5.00 when she went to the store. If she bought 1 scarf what is the most expensive item she can buy with the money she has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$1.50 = \$3.50$$

- 6) The table below shows the prices of several items at the school store.

Item	Price
eraser	\$3.55
notepad	\$2.90
pencil	\$2.00
pen	\$2.35
marker	\$2.65

Roger had \$5.00 when he went to the store. If he bought 1 pencil what is the most expensive item he can buy with the money he has left?

$$\$5.00 - \$2.00 = \$3.00$$
