A pint is about the amount you get in a large glass.

$$1 \text{ pint} = 2 \text{ cups}$$

Quart

A quart is about the amount you get in a large milk container.

$$1 \text{ quart} = 2 \text{ pints}$$


Gallon

A gallon is the amount that comes in the large plastic container.

$$1 \text{ gallon} = 4 \text{ quarts}$$




